HOW TO KNOW WHAT TO SELL AT JBF OAKLAND COUNTY



Clean

The newer it looks, the better it sells. Plan to clean clothes, shoes, equipment and toys.



Current

Sell clothing and shoes in current styles and fashion. Make sure they're the right season!



Complete

Toys, games and puzzles must be sold as a complete set without missing pieces.



Compliant

Safety guidelines apply to selling a car seat, stroller, baby equipment and toys. Check <https://www.cpsc.gov> for recalls.

Our sale's success (and the size of your seller paycheck!) depend on us providing a shopping experience with clean, high quality, gently used baby and kids items.

Clothing items with stains, holes, tears, excessive pilling, or excessive wear can't be accepted for the sale. We recommend you recycle these items with a free textile recycling company. Shoes should be clean and near new condition without notable scuffs. Please use household items like magic erasers, stain sprays, etc to ensure items are free of blemishes.

Toys and gear should be free of marks and damage and require all pieces for safety and functionality. Any toys requiring batteries need those batteries installed prior to the sale. Dollar stores are a great place to buy affordable batteries. Books should have all pages without tears, tape, or writing inside.
